ABOUT GATI SHAKTI

It is essentially a digital platform to bring 16 Ministries together (including Railways and Roadways) for integrated planning and coordinated implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects.

 An integrated multimodal Network Planning Group (NPG) will be responsible for unified planning and integration of proposals. This entire platform has been developed by the Bhaskaracharya National Institute for Space Applications and Geoinformatics (BISAG).

• Comprehensiveness -

- o It will include all the existing and planned initiatives of various Ministries and Departments with one centralized portal.

• Synchronization -

- Individual Ministries and Departments often work in silos.
- There is lack of coordination in planning and implementation of the project resulting in delays.
- PM Gati Shakti will help in synchronizing the activities of each department, as well as of different layers of governance, in a holistic manner by ensuring coordination of work between them.

Analytical –

The plan will provide the entire data at one place with GIS based spatial planning and analytical tools having 200+ layers, enabling better visibility to the executing agency.

Dynamic –

- All Ministries and Departments will now be able to visualize, review and monitor the progress of cross-sectoral projects, through the GIS platform.
- Satellite imagery will give on-ground progress periodically and progress of the projects will be updated on a regular basis on the portal.
- It will help in identifying the vital interventions for enhancing and updating the master plan.

OPERATION BRAHMA

In a swift response to the devastating earthquake that struck Myanmar on 28th March 2025, the Indian Army, under 'Operation Brahma', is deploying a specialised medical task force to provide urgent humanitarian assistance.

WHO WILL GO FROM INDIA?

- A 118-member team from the elite Shatrujeet Brigade Medical Responders, led by

 Lieutenant Colonel Jagneet Gill, is set takeoff to Myanmar shortly along with

 essential medical equipment and supplies.
- The Airborne Angels Task Force is trained and equipped to deliver advanced medical and surgical care in disaster-affected zones.

As part of the operation, the **Indian Army will establish a 60-bed Medical Treatment**Centre to provide immediate care to those injured in the calamity.

WHY HAS INDIA UNDERTAKEN THIS?

This humanitarian assistance underlines India's commitment to its 'Neighbourhood First' policy and the timeless Indian ethos of 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' – the world is one family.

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The Indian Army continues to stand shoulder to shoulder with friendly nations in times of crisis, reflecting India's resolve to be a first responder in the region.

The deployment has been coordinated closely with the **Ministry of External Affairs** and in partnership with authorities in Myanmar.
