Indo Pacific is home to more than 64% of the global population and which contributes over 60% of world's GDP. About half of the global trade happens through the maritime trade routes in this region.

MEMBERS OF QUAD:

The grouping of four democracies – **India, Australia, US and Japan** – is known as the quadrilateral security dialogue or quad.

AIM OF QUAD:

The aim of this grouping is to ensure a free and open international order based on the rule of law in the Indo-Pacific.

OBJECTIVES:

- · Maritime security,
- Combating the Covid-19 crisis, especially vis-à-vis vaccine diplomacy,
- · Addressing the risks of climate change,
- · Creating an ecosystem for investment in the region and
- Boosting technological innovation.

EVOLUTION OF QUAD:

 Following the Indian Ocean tsunami, India, Japan, Australia, and the US created an informal alliance to collaborate on disaster relief efforts.




- Quad as a formal group was first mooted by Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe
 in 2007.
- However, due to Chinese resistance and reluctance shown by India, it could not move ahead.
- Later, during the 2017 ASEAN Summits, all four former members re-joined negotiations to revive the quadrilateral alliance.
- The Quad was upgraded to the ministerial level in September 2019.





SAMUDRAYAAN MISSION



India is now set to launch 'Samudrayaan' - involving its first manned submersible vehicle called 'Matsya-6000', which will descend 6,000 metres into the Bay of Bengal with a three-man crew.

ABOUT SAMUDRAYAAN MISSION

- Samudrayaan Mission is aimed to develop a self-propelled manned submersible
 to carry three human beings to a water depth of 6,000 meters in the ocean with a
 suite of scientific sensors and tools for deep ocean exploration.
- The experts will be sent in a manned submersible vehicle called 'MATSYA 6000'.
- This vehicle is being designed and developed by the National Institute of Ocean
 Technology (NIOT), Chennai under the Ministry of Earth Sciences.
- It has an **endurance of 12 hours** under normal operation and 96 hours in case of emergency for human safety.
- Manned submersible provides a feel of direct physical presence for researchers and has better intervention capability.
- With the launch of 'Samudrayaan' in October 2021, <u>India joined the elite club</u> of nations such as the **US**, **Russia**, **Japan**, **France**, and **China** to have niche technology and vehicles to carry out subsea activities.

RELEVANCE FOR INDIA

- India has a unique maritime position, a 7517 km long coastline, which is home to nine coastal states and 1,382 islands.
- The mission aims to boost the Central government's vision of 'New India' that highlights the Blue Economy as one of the ten core dimensions of growth.
- For India, with its three sides surrounded by the oceans and around 30% of the nation's population living in coastal areas and coastal regions play a major economic factor. It supports fisheries and aquaculture, tourism, livelihoods, and blue trade.



INDIAN DIASPORA

Diaspora is derived from a greek word - Diasperein.

Diasperien means dispersion. Hence Diaspora is the dispersed people from India.

Indian Diaspora = NRI + OCI (Prior to 2015, it was NRI + PIO + OCI. PIO merged into OCI in

2015)

SIGNIFICANCE

ECONOMIC:

- Remittances to India: India receives more than 85 bn USD annually as remittances & it is predicted to be around 100 bn USD in 2022.
- o Flow of business ideas, tacit information & technology into India.
- Migration of less skilled labour from India creates a reduced pressure in India for employment generation.

POLITICAL:

Indians hold critical positions of power in many countries like USA, Mauritius,
 UK etc.

WHERE IS INDIAN DIASPORA SETTLING?

A total of **1,63,370** Indians **relinquished Indian Citizenship in 2021** and received citizenship from other countries, a trend noted highest since 2019.



According to the government data, over 3.9 lakh citizens have given up their citizenship in the past 3 years to settle abroad.

The data mentions that there are 103 countries where Indians relinquished Indian citizenship.
