Prime Minister attended the 20th ASEAN-India Summit and the 18th East Asia Summit

(EAS) in Jakarta on 7 September 2023.

At the ASEAN-India Summit, Prime Minister held extensive discussions with ASEAN partners

on further strengthening of ASEAN-India Comprehensive Strategic Partnership and charting its future course.

Prime Minister reaffirmed ASEAN centrality in the Indo-Pacific and highlighted the synergies between India's Indo-Pacific Ocean's Initiative (IPOI) and ASEAN's Outlook on

the Indo-Pacific (AOIP).

In addition to India and ASEAN Leaders, **Timor-Leste participated** in the Summit as **Observor.**

- Announced renewal of support to Economic and Research Institute of ASEAN and


East Asia (ERIA) to act as knowledge partner for enhancing our engagement.

EAST ASIA SUMMIT

At the **18th East Asia Summit**, Prime Minister reiterated the importance of EAS mechanism and reaffirmed our support to further strengthening it. Prime Minister underlined India's support for **ASEAN centrality** and called for ensuring a **free**, **open and rules based Indo-Pacific.**


Prime Minister highlighted synergies of visions for Indo-Pacific between India and ASEAN, and underscored that **ASEAN is the focal point of Quad's vision.**

Prime Minister also called for a cooperative approach to address global challenges including **terrorism, climate change and resilient supply chains** for essential items including food and medicines, and for energy security. He highlighted India's steps in the area of climate change and our initiatives such as ISA, CDRI, LiFE and OSOWOG.

MISSION LIFE

ABOUT THE MISSION:

Mission LiFE is an India-led global mass movement which aims to nudge individual and collective action to protect and preserve the environment.

Its concept was introduced by the PM at the United Nations Framework Convention on

Climate Change (UNFCCC) COP-26 (Conference of the Parties) in Glasgow.

Implementation: NITI Aayog will curate and incubate Mission LiFE in the first year. Subsequently, it will be implemented by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC).

OBJECTIVE

- Mobilise at least 1 billion Indians and other global citizens to take individual and collective action for protecting and preserving the environment in the period 2022 to 2027.
- Within India, at least 80% of all villages and urban local bodies are aimed to become environment-friendly by 2028.
- Mission Duration: It will run as a 5-year programme.
- In 2022-23, the mission will focus on Phase I.

- The IECC complex is India's largest MICE (Meetings, Incentives, Conferences, and Exhibitions) destination and features state-of-the-art facilities, including a convention centre, exhibition halls, and an amphitheatre.
- The architectural design of the convention centre incorporates elements from India's traditional art and culture, representing the nation's rich heritage and modern achievements.
- Significance: Bharat Mandapam is the venue for the G20 summit, 2023.



poets and socio-spiritual reformers known as Sharanas discussed and deliberated on

various reforms.

Who was Lord Basaveshwara?

Basaveshwara (1134-1196), also known as Basavanna, was a 12th-century poet, philosopher, and social reformer from Bagevadi, Karnataka. He was appointed as Prime

Minister by the Kalachuri king Bijjala.

He was the founder of Lingayatism.


The term Lingayat denotes a person who wears a personal linga, an iconic form of the god


Shiva, on the body which is received during the initiation ceremony. They are the

dominant group in Karnataka, said to be about 17 percent of the population in the state.

Advocated for a society free of the caste system, with equal opportunity for all, and preached

about manual hard work
